



Even years are convention years, and at this time of the year many of our members are looking forward to reconnect with fellow members and friends from other lodges. We are also looking forward to discussing organization business, at least I am. The Sons of Norway governance model makes the International Lodge the supreme decision-making authority and its meetings are therefore, of the utmost importance for the organization.

In the June issue of the Viking Magazine, our International President, Jon Tehven, is discussing good governance focusing on nominating committees which were fairly recently implemented at both the international and district levels. He says: "These committees have been tasked with seeking out the best qualified, interested individuals who are willing and able to serve." From what I have seen in our district, the committee has certainly worked hard to find members who are interested and willing to serve, but I see no evidence of vetting the candidates. The International President goes on to say in his column in the Viking Magazine: "The committee screen applicants and present all those who are eligible, based on the requirements of the position." Really, we have job descriptions. But what are the requirements for say an International Secretary, or District Secretary? What I have seen in our district is that the committee tries to get a slate together of members interested in serving, end of story. In other words pretty much what we have done for years at the local lodge level. And I don't know if it is any different at the International Lodge level either, but we may know more come August and the International Convention. But does this really satisfy scrutiny by regulators?

An added complication this year is the unfortunate decision made by the International Lodge at its meeting two years ago that nominations cannot be made from the floor at the district level. In our district we have had problems for years filling all the officer positions, and at times only succeeding just prior to when the elections were to take place. There are things that are best left to the districts, and accepting nominations from the floor is an example of this.

Another thing best left to districts and local lodges is setting dues. The ill-prepared uniform dues structure approved two years ago, has as an example, presented our district with unnecessary new challenges as the fraternal fee has been discontinued. The Third District has had a fraternal fee for years supporting the operation of Land of the Vikings. Without it, LOV which is showing signs of improvements, must find other ways to shore up its finances, likely to be fund raising. But fund raising is a problem as the district and the local lodges also rely on fund raising for their needs. And it is always the same people who are being asked, which is an added problem. It would be nice and helpful if the International Board would review these most unfortunate decisions.
